



# Video Verification



## Alerted Remote Response

One of the most common forms of video monitoring is video verification. With this service, a clip from a surveillance video camera is sent to the G4S Risk Operations Center (ROC) when triggered either by internal motion detection built into the camera or through a trigger from an alarm system — such as when someone opens a protected door. Having the video image helps the ROC operator determine whether an intruder is present or whether the event was triggered by some other cause such as an animal.

Operators then use this to verify the nature of the alarm event and take appropriate action as defined in the customer agreement and post orders. This highly efficient approach reduces the need for high-bandwidth internet connections and often more costly streaming camera installations, while still providing speedy review and response to events on the customer premises.
